Precis of the talk given to the March Group Meeting by Lyane Kendall, Strays Officer NZSG.

Who is a Stray?

A stray is a person associated with two different locations within the same recorded event.

Background Information.

Members of the NZSG are encouraged to submit entries and request searches to and from the Strays Officer.

Some examples from where information is found.

- ♦ New Zealand Civil Registrations:
 - ⇒ Births.

From 1875 onwards the parents' birthplace was added to the information required to register a birth in NZ.

⇒ Marriages.

From 1881, in the case of a marriage registered in NZ, the birthplaces of both the bride and groom were added.

⇒ Deaths.

From 1875 deaths registered in NZ included the birthplace of the deceased.

- Shipping Lists.
- ♦ Biographies.
- School Admission Records.
- Parish Registars.
- England & Wales Civil Registration.
- ♦ Census.

Strays can also be found in other records such as NZ Probates Index; Birth, deaths, marriage and engagement newspaper notices; Cemetery transcriptions; NZ Gazettes; Cyclopaedia of NZ and many more.

How the Strays Service Work.

Data submission forms can be obtained by sending a stamped addressed envelope to the Strays Officer. The information submitted must be concise and accurate.

Requesting a search of the database.

This can be done by obtaining a search request form from the Strays Officer and providing sufficient information to enable a search to be carried out.
